“Provisionals, Splints, Equilibration & Specialist Relations: How the Pankey Institute Changed My Practice”

Comprehensive diagnosis and appropriate treatment are the foundation for creating a practice with long term patients and staff. Knowledge of all factors that contribute to or detract from long optimum oral health is best determined at the initial examination. Educating patients to the benefits of occlusal stability for long term preservation of natural teeth and predictable restorative work creates a better practice for everyone. The specific role of provisional restoration, splint therapy, equilibration will be illustrated. A key to building a high quality restorative practice is specialist interaction. A protocol to enhance this relationship will be discussed.

Roger A. Solow, DDS graduated UCLA in 1975 with a BA in Biology and his dental degree from University of the Pacific Dental School in 1978. He has been a clinical instructor in Operative dentistry at UOP, a member of the Operative Academy, and the American Equilibration Society. He has been on the visiting faculty of the Pankey Institute in Key Biscayne Florida since 2000. He has published articles on original clinical technique in the Journal of Prosthetic Dentistry and Cranio. He has lectured to the Academy of General Dentistry and study clubs on implant restoration, occlusal analysis, splint therapy, and post orthodontic equilibration.
