Dr. Woo and Dr. DeBerardinis will be presenting a review of current treatment protocols in Orthodontics. Current concepts will be presented and supported with cases that have been treated or are in progress. Topics to be presented include, but are not limited to Orthognathic/Orthodontic surgical treatment, early/interceptive treatment, Orthodontic implant anchorage, class II and class III correction, treatment of impacted teeth, multidisciplinary adult orthodontics, and pre-restorative orthodontic treatment for lateral incisor tooth-size discrepancies. Biographical Information: Marc De Berardinis, D.M.D., M.S.

Dr. DeBerardinis was born and raised on the East Coast, and has been living and practicing in Northern California for 6 years. “Dr. D.” graduated Summa Cum Laude from Temple University School of Dentistry in Philadelphia, P.A., where he received his Doctor of Dental Medicine degree in 1996. Dr. D. went on to study orthodontics in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, where he received his Masters of Science degree and Orthodontic certificate in 1998. In addition to practicing orthodontics in Petaluma, Dr. D. is also an Assistant Clinical Professor of Orthodontics at U.C. San Francisco School of Dentistry. His involvement in academics allows first-hand exposure to the latest clinical research and techniques. By being an attending faculty member, Dr. D. supervises the treatment of orthodontic patients by the residents, and helps them along their path in becoming future orthodontists.

Biographical Information: John Woo, D.D.S, M.S.

Dr. Woo is a native Californian born and raised in Sunnyvale. He attended U.C. Santa Barbara where he graduated with honors with a degree in Biology. At U.C. San Francisco School of Dentistry he was president of the research group and sat on the admissions committee. He was given The Dean’s Award for his achievements in dental school, and upon graduation he received his degree as a Doctor of Dental Surgery and graduated with honors. In addition, through a fellowship between U.C.S.F. and the University of Vienna, Austria he studied the temporomandibular joint (jaw joint) and its disorders. He attended St. Louis Medical Center for his degree in Orthodontics and also received a Master’s degree in Dental Science. He began practicing orthodontics in Petaluma in 1993.
